Sub: Assignments – Visakhapatnam district- Visakhapatnam (Rural) mandal – Madhurwada village land measuring Ac.4.67 cts covered by Sy.N.335/1 assigned to Smt. Ch.Savitri W/o (late) Raghavarao, Ex-serviceman – Govt. permitted the assignee to sell away the land in terms of G.O.Ms.No.1117 Dt. 11.11.1993 – withdrawal of the land from Section 22-A of registration act – Orders issued- reg.

ORDER:

Smt Ch.Savitri W/o (Late) Raghavararao, Ex-serviceman resident of Visakhapatnam has submitted a representation to the Hon'ble Chief Minister requesting to grant of NOC to sell away the land assigned to her measuring AC.4.67 cts covered by Sy.No.335/1 of Madhurwada village of Visakhapatnam (Rural) mandal. The Prl. Secretary to Chief Minister, vide reference 1<sup>st</sup> read above, has forwarded her representation to the District Collector, Visakhapatnam to examine and take further action in the matter

In the reference 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, the Tahsildar, Visakhapatnam (Rural) has submitted a detailed report on the subject matter of the land duly stating that the assignee's husband was worked in Indian Army as sepoy during the World War-II and after his demise, the land in question was assigned to Smt. Ch.Saavitri in the year 1978. Accordingly, a detailed report has been submitted to the Govt. vide reference 3<sup>rd</sup> read above.

The Government vide reference 4<sup>th</sup> read above, while discussing the case in detail has stated that, in view of the recommendations of the Spl. Chief Secretary & CCLA, Hyderabad, the Govt. have decided to consider the request of Smt. Ch.Savitramma who is in continuous possession of the assigned land to an extent of Ac.4.67 cts in Sy.No.335/1 of Madhurawada village for treating her assignment under ex-servicemen quota since her husband was ex-serviceman worked as Sepoy in IInd World War duly relaxing the conditions relating to the date of application as recommended by the CCLA, that she is eligible for grant of NOC under GO Ms.No.1117 Revenue dated 11.11.1993. Further, the Government have requested the District Collector to take necessary action in accordance with the orders issued in G.O ms.No.1117 Revenue (Assignment -1) Dept dt.11.11.1993.

In terms of G.O.Ms.No.1117 Revenue (Assignment) Dept Dt. 11.11.1993, the ex-servicemen are free to sell away their assigned land after a period of 10 years from the date of assignment. Further, the land in question has been notified u/s 22-A of registration act vide G.O.Ms.No.583 Revenue (Registration-1) 4<sup>th</sup> May 2005.

In view of the circumstances stated above, Smt. Ch.Savitri W/o (late) Raghavarao, Ex-serviceman is permitted to sell away the land assigned to her measuring Ac.4.67 cts covered by Sy.No.335/1 of Madhurawada village of Visakhapatnam (Rural) mandal and the land in question is withdrawn from Sec.22-A of registration act.
